

## ICCFA University Scholarship Opportunity

Starting in 2009, the Central States Cemetery Association scholarship was made possible by an endowment from the CSCA to the International Cemetery Cremation & Funeral Association Educational Foundation to specifically establish an annual scholarship award to the ICCFA University. Applicants must work in one of the central states of Arkansas, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma or Wisconsin, and be employed by a cemetery for a minimum of two years. The scholarship covers tuition, lodging and a one-year ICCFA membership.

ICCFA University is the only school of its kind for cemetery, cremation and funeral service professionals. It includes six educational tracks, or "colleges": College of 21st Century Services; College of Administration and Management; College of Cremation Services; College of Funeral Home Management; College of Land Management and Grounds Operations; and the J. Asher Need College of Sales and Marketing. In addition, ICCFA University offers a master's program and a CEO program.

Founded in 1887, the International Cemetery, Cremation and Funeral Association is the only international trade association representing all segments of the cemetery, cremation, funeral and memorialization profession. Its membership is composed of more than 7,400 cemeteries, funeral homes, crematories, memorial designers and related businesses worldwide.
